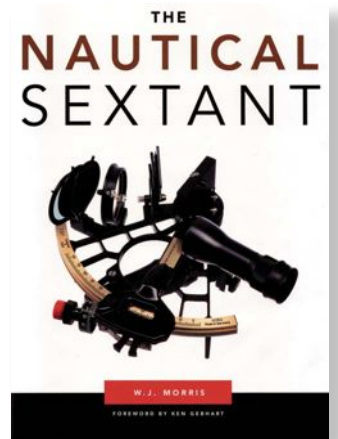

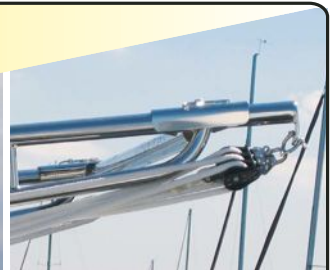
and is of value not only to navigators, but also to restorers, collectors, curators and sextant dealers.
